NEIGHBORHOOD LIAISON STEPS TO FOLLOW IN A DISASTER

1. ASSESS YOURSELF

- >Check members of household and pets for injuries
- >Check your structure for damage
- >Make sure family is safe and secure

2. DISASTER/EMERGENCY PLAN ACTIVATED

- >Through checking in with your Area Coordinator (AC).
- 3. ASSESS NEIGHBORHOOD (in teams of 2)
- >By telephone if feasible, if no answer or phones out, visit the home.
- 4. REPORT EMERGENCIES ASAP THROUGH QUICKEST AVAILABLE MEANS. CALL 911 FIRST (or have someone else do it; make sure it gets done). THEN RADIO-REPORT TO YOUR AC. IF 911 CAN'T BE CALLED, RADIO-REPORT HAS HIGHEST PRIORITY.
- 5. REPORT ENTIRE NEIGHBORHOOD ASSESSMENT (AFTER CHECKING ALL HOMES) TO YOUR AC. IF NO PROBLEMS IN SOME SECTIONS, LET AC KNOW WHEN RADIO TRAFFIC EASES OFF.
